

Respiratory Virus Multiplex PCR: November findings

- The most frequently detected viruses during November were Rhino/Enterovirus (37%), Rhinovirus (26.6%), Parainfluenza virus (1-4) (14%) and Adenovirus (14%)
- Both Influenza A and Influenza B virus were circulating at extremely low levels during November.
- RSV was circulating at low levels during November
- There has been a slight increase in the amount of Enterovirus from 5% in October to 8% in November.
- Please note: the Graph includes the combined data from different Respiratory Multiplex assays offered by Ampath laboratories.
