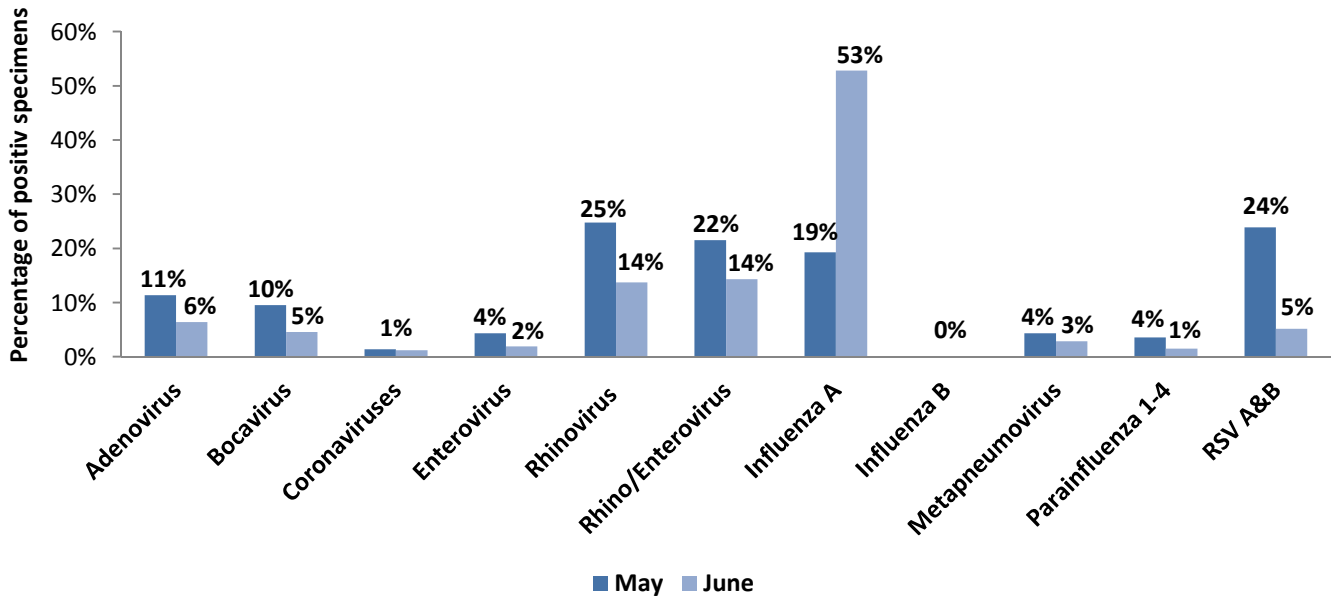
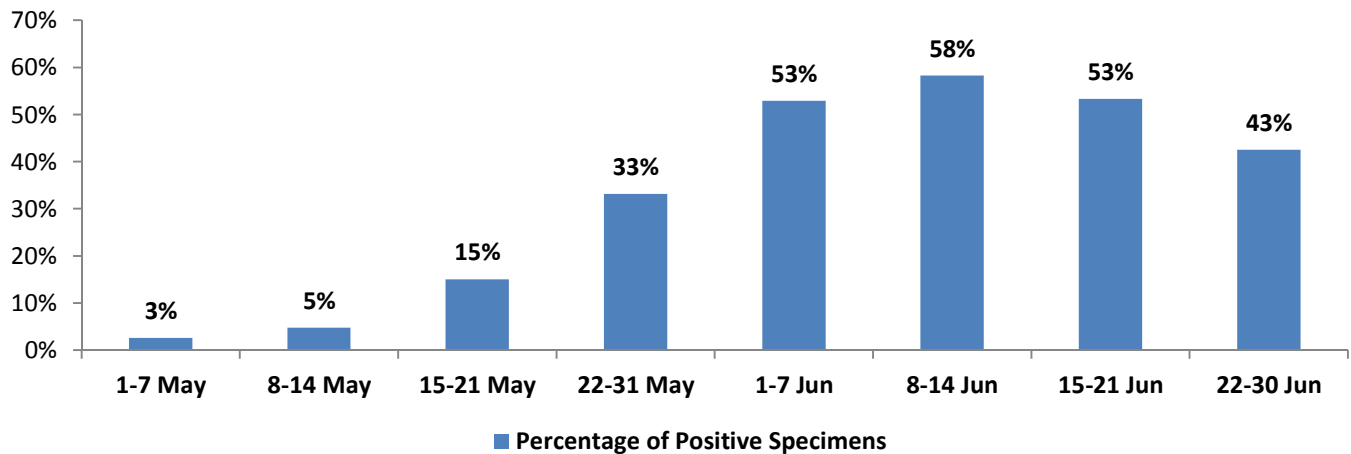

Influenza A: Positive Specimens per week (May/June)



Respiratory Virus Multiplex PCR Findings

- The most frequently detected viruses during June were Influenza A (53%) and Rhinovirus (14%)
- During the second week in June there was a peak in the amount of Influenza A positive specimens detected in Gauteng province. The predominant influenza A strain detected was H3.
- No Influenza B virus was detected during June.
