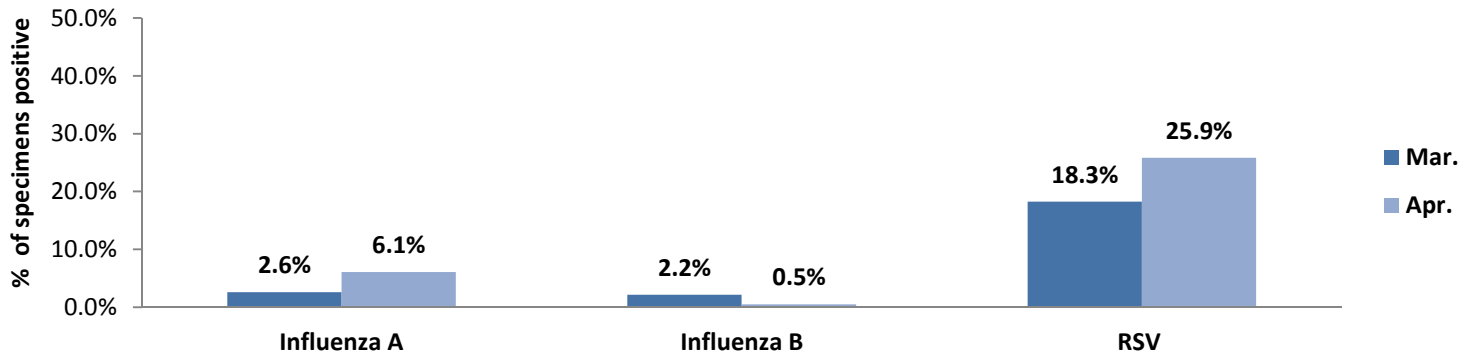


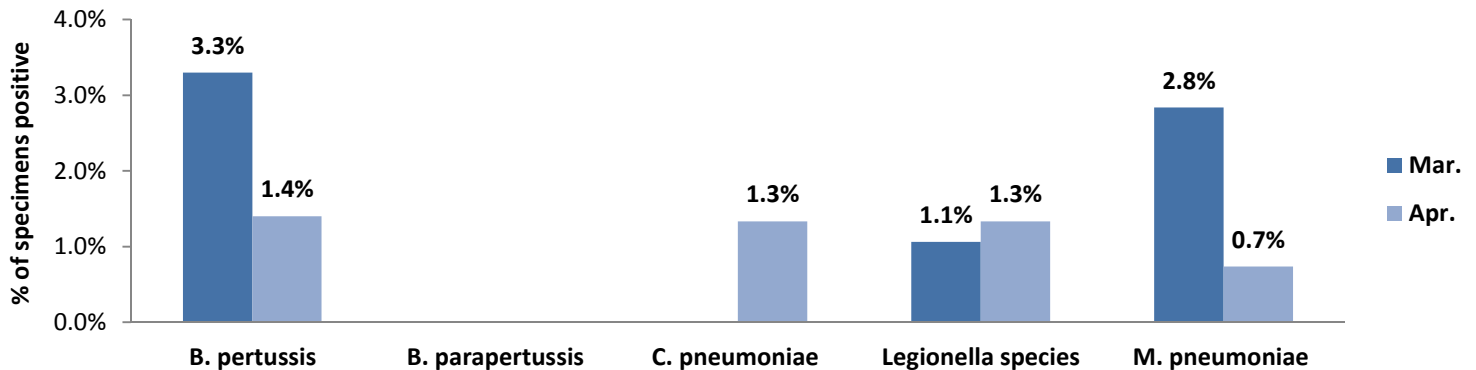
# Respiratory virus and Atypical Bacteria PCR statistics (Excluding Cape Town and KwaZulu-Natal)



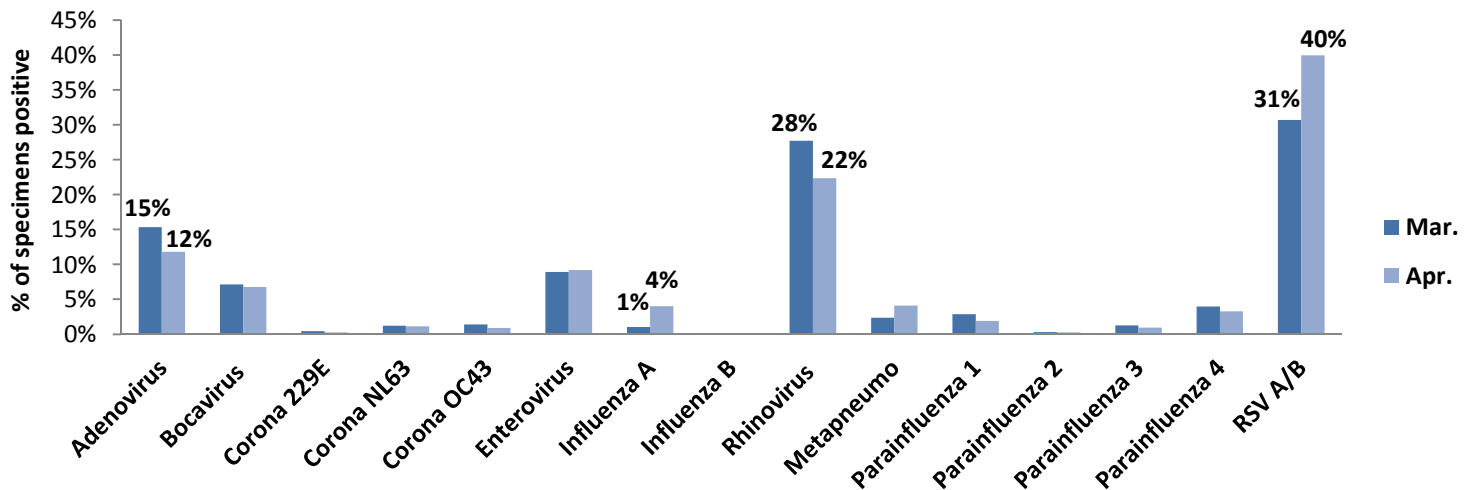
## Influenza A/B & RSV Multiplex PCR: March/April 2018

## Respiratory Virus Multiplex PCR: March/April 2018



**Influenza A/B & RSV Multiplex PCR:** Both RSV and Influenza A activity has increased during April.

**Atypical Bacterial PCR:** Low levels of atypical bacteria were found during April.

**Respiratory Virus Multiplex PCR:** The most frequently detected viruses during April were RSV (40%), rhinovirus (22%), adenovirus (12%). RSV activity has increased to 40% of specimens testing positive during April. Influenza A activity has increased to 4% of specimens testing positive during April.
