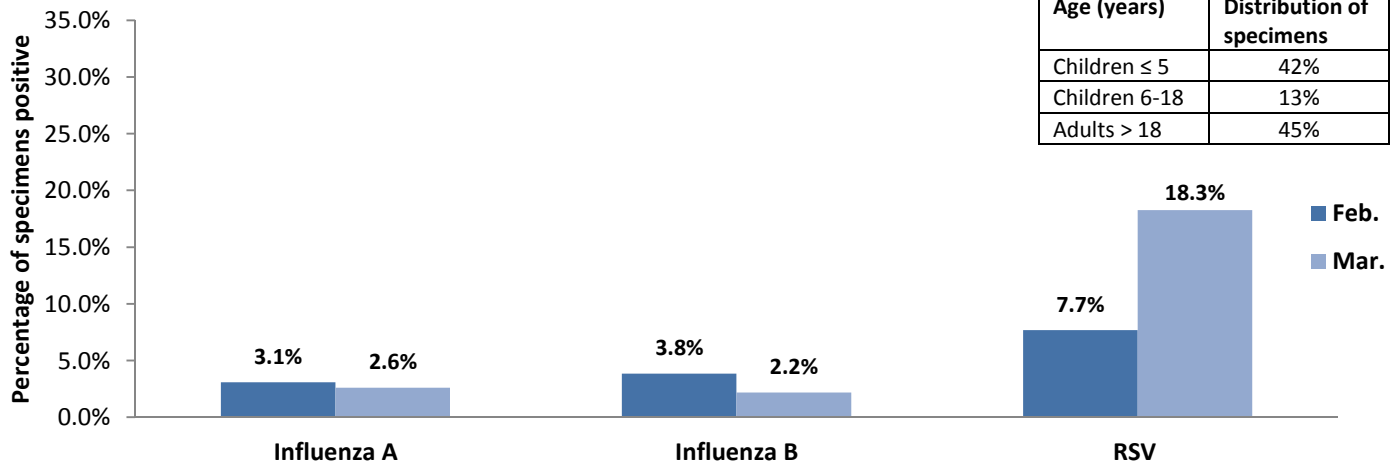
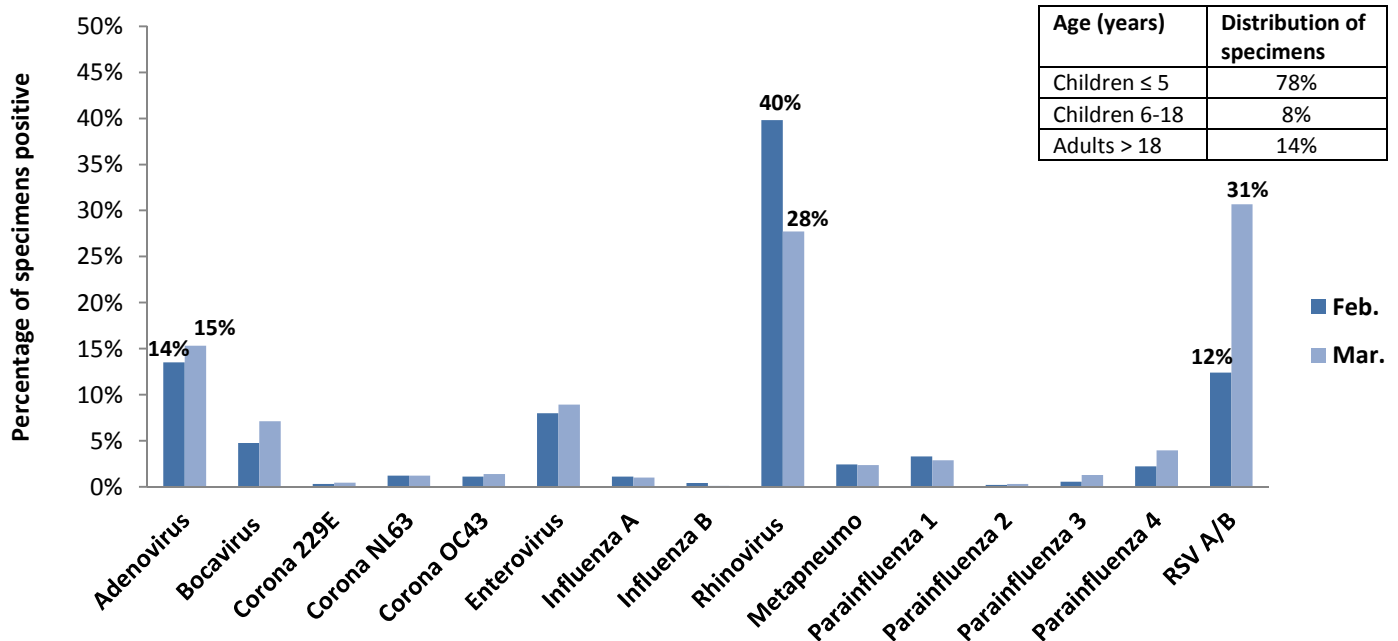

February findings	Influenza A/B & RSV Multiplex PCR	Respiratory Virus Multiplex PCR
	<p>Influenza A and Influenza B activity remain low during March.</p> <p>RSV activity has increased from 7.7% of specimens testing positive in February to 18.3% of specimens testing positive in March.</p>	<p>The most frequently detected viruses in March were RSV (31%), rhinovirus (28%), adenovirus (15%).</p> <p>RSV activity has increased substantially from 12% of specimens testing positive in February to 31% of specimens testing positive March, making it the most common virus detected in March.</p>
