
Respiratory Virus PCR Statistics KwaZulu-Natal Province October/November 2019



Respiratory Virus Multiplex PCR: November findings

- The most frequently detected viruses during November were Rhino/Enterovirus (37%) and Parainfluenza viruses 1-4 (13%).
- Influenza A is circulating at extremely low levels.
- No Influenza B or RSV were detected during November.
